SeaTrek Kayak Adventure — A Paddle in Paradise!

Easy to row, "sit on top" kayaks, the perfect way to enjoy the serene waters of LabadeeSM while you learn about its unique history. 1 1/2 hours long, with equipment included. Your SeaTrek instructor will give you all the instructions you need.



SeaTrek Parasail Adventure - Get up there!

Come fly the skies of Labadee. This tour will take you up 400-feet above Labadee for a breathtaking and memorable flight. Enjoy the panoramic scenery of Labadee and the surrounding islands from a birds eye view. Guests between the ages of 12-15 must fly with a parent or guardian. Minimum age 12 years. Everyone flies tandem. Boat ride will be approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour. Duration of flight 5 - 6 minutes. Maximum of 375 lbs. *Get out there.*SM

WELCOME TO LABADEESM

Although originally said to have been discovered by Christopher Columbus in 1492, it wasn't until Royal Caribbean discovered it five centuries later that it became the secluded tropical paradise that it is today. The two main historical monuments on LabadeeSM are Nellie's Place and the Old Bell Tower. Legend has it that Nellie was an Englishwoman who arrived at the time of the buccaneers and set up a trading post and tavern for visiting ships and their crews. The Old Bell Tower was erected to announce their arrival. The actual bell in the tower was plundered long before the arrival of Royal Caribbean, but was previously used to ring out across the hillsides and let local farmers know when to bring their produce down to the quay. Recent renovations have been completed so you can swim and snorkel, take lunch, and enjoy a cocktail in almost the very same atmosphere that Columbus and his crew experienced all those centuries ago. You can join in the activities, swing idly in a hammock, or simply take a walk out along the headland to Dragon's Breath Point. Officially named Pointe Honorat, it has been renamed Dragon's Breath because of the churning seas which force water upwards through a sumphole in the rocks, producing the breathing of Labadee's very own dragon!

General Information

ACCESSIBILITY: Complimentary beach wheelchairs are available for guests with disabilities at the Tender Landing. Wheelchairs are easily accommodated at all food and beverage venues, restrooms, beaches & tram.

TENDERING: Tenders are available for Guest transportation to/from the destination. Please consult your Cruise Compass for first and last departure times. Please return the towels to the Ship and don't forget your SeaPass.

SAFETY FIRST: Please be aware that Labadee is part of a natural coral island. The rough coral is often difficult to detect, lying just below the sand. Proper footwear and caution is strongly suggested.

HEALTH AND FIRST AID: Because the tropical sun's rays can be very deceptive, even on cloudy days, we suggest the use of sun-screen and, if necessary, light protective clothing such as T-shirts and cover-ups. It is advisable to have some footwear as a protection against the hot sand and pathways. Try to avoid strenuous activity on shore or in the water after eating. To reduce the risk of dehydration, drink plenty of liquids. Our First Aid Station is manned throughout the day.

SWIMMING AND WATERSPORTS: For your safety, particular beaches have been designated for swimming and snorkeling. A snorkeling safety vest is required and can be rented for a nominal fee at the Snorkel Shack.

SHOPPING: (Cash Only). Labadee offers two types of shopping experiences.

THE ARTISAN MARKET:

Harry's: fine carved statues and tableware.
Les Ateliers Toggart: tapestries, exotic fabrics, and wall hangings.
Connie's: handmade pottery, jewelry, and paper maché.
Rum of Haiti: world-famous Barbancourt rum and liqueurs.
Carlos: hand-decorated skirts, dresses, shorts, and shirts.
Gallerie Trois Visages: distinctive art by some of Haiti's best.

THE AUTHENTIC HAITIAN FLEA MARKET: Be ready to bargain, the vendors are eager to make a sale.

LUNCH: Enjoy our complimentary BBQ Lunch at any one of our three designated food facilities. Please consult your Cruise Compass for hours of operation.

BEVERAGE PURCHASE: Payment for beverages ashore is by way of your SeaPass card only.

FRESH WATER: Water in the restrooms is NOT intended for drinking. Drinking water is available by the glass at all bar locations and cafés.

PLANTS AND MARINE LIFE: Please help us to preserve the natural beauty of Labadee by not picking the flowers or removing marine life such as shells or coral from the water.

GARBAGE: Your cooperation is requested in keeping Labadee free of garbage. Kindly use the receptacles provided.

LOUNGE CHAIRS: Just as on board, lounge chairs on Labadee are complimentary. They cannot be reserved and guests are kindly requested not to offer payment for the chairs. This also applies to hammocks found throughout the beach area.

ADVENTURE OCEAN[®]: Children and Teens ages 3 to 17 will have activities supervised by your Youth Staff at the Labadee Adventure Ocean Facility. Consult your Cruise Compass for time and location of activities.
